A complimentary cross stitch Easter Egg by Brooke Nolan



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Needed to complete Easter Egg: 1 pc. 6" x 9" White 14 ct. perforated paper, listed DMC floss, (You will also need DMC #310 Black floss for backstitching.) Mill Hill glass seed beads, #24 tapestry needle, short beading needle, 1/4" wide pink satin ribbon for bow and hanger, embroidery scissors or craft knife, glue, and decorative paper for backing the egg.

Finished Easter Egg measures approximately 4" x 6".

Cross Stitch & Bead: Using 3 strands of floss, cross stitch the egg on perforated paper. Then, using 2 strands of DMC #818, complete the beading. (Note: If you have trouble threading a beading needle with 2 strands of floss, put 1 strand of floss through the eye and pull the end down so there are 2 working strands.)

Backstitch: using 1 strand of DMC #844, stitch the bunny's mouth & nose. Using 1 strand of DMC #310, stitch the bunny's eyes. Using 2 strands of DMC White, stitch bunny's left ear. Using 2 strands of DMC #414, stitch bunny's right ear and right side of face.

Finishing Instructions: Using embroidery scissors or a craft knife, cut out the stitched and beaded egg and flowers leaving borders of at least one square beyond the outer most stitches of each piece. Make a bow with 1/4" wide pink satin ribbon and tack in place. (See photo.) Back the egg by glueing a square of decorative paper that is 1 or 2 inches larger than the perimeter of the stitched egg to the back, wrong sides together. After backing is dry, carefully cut away the excess backing close to the edges of the egg. Attach stitched flowers by tacking or gluing in place. For a more dimensional look, use pop dots or tiny pieces of Velcro to attach flowers. Thread more satin ribbon through the top of egg to make a hanger.

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






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This top shaded row is the repeated bottom row of pg. 3 chart. Use it to align the two halves. Do not stitch it twice.



Using embroidery scissors or a craft knife, cut out the stitched and beaded flowers and egg leaving borders of at least one square beyond the outer most stitches of each piece.
