## Candy Corn Corner Bookmark Cross Stitch Chart Only

Use 3 plies floss to cross stitch on paper  
Use 1 ply #8 braid to cross stitch on paper

### Cross Stitch Key

Symbols	DMC	Color	Skeins
■	310	Black	1
⊗	727	Topaz Vy Lt	1
⊕	970	Pumpkin Lt	1
⊘	3689	Mauve Lt	1
I	603	Cranberry	1
2	209	Lavender Dk	1
♣	3746	Blue Violet Dk	1

You will also need 1 skein of DMC Blanc for back stitching.

Symbol	Kreinik (#8 Fine Braids)	Color	Spools
+	9032	Easter Braid	1
♥	091	Star Yellow	1
▣	5765	Orange Sherbet	1

Model was stitched on 14 count Midnight Black & Misty Lavender perforated paper with DMC floss & Kreinik #8 Fine Braids.

The completed Candy Corn Bookmark, as pictured on the cover, is approximately 3.25" x 3.25"

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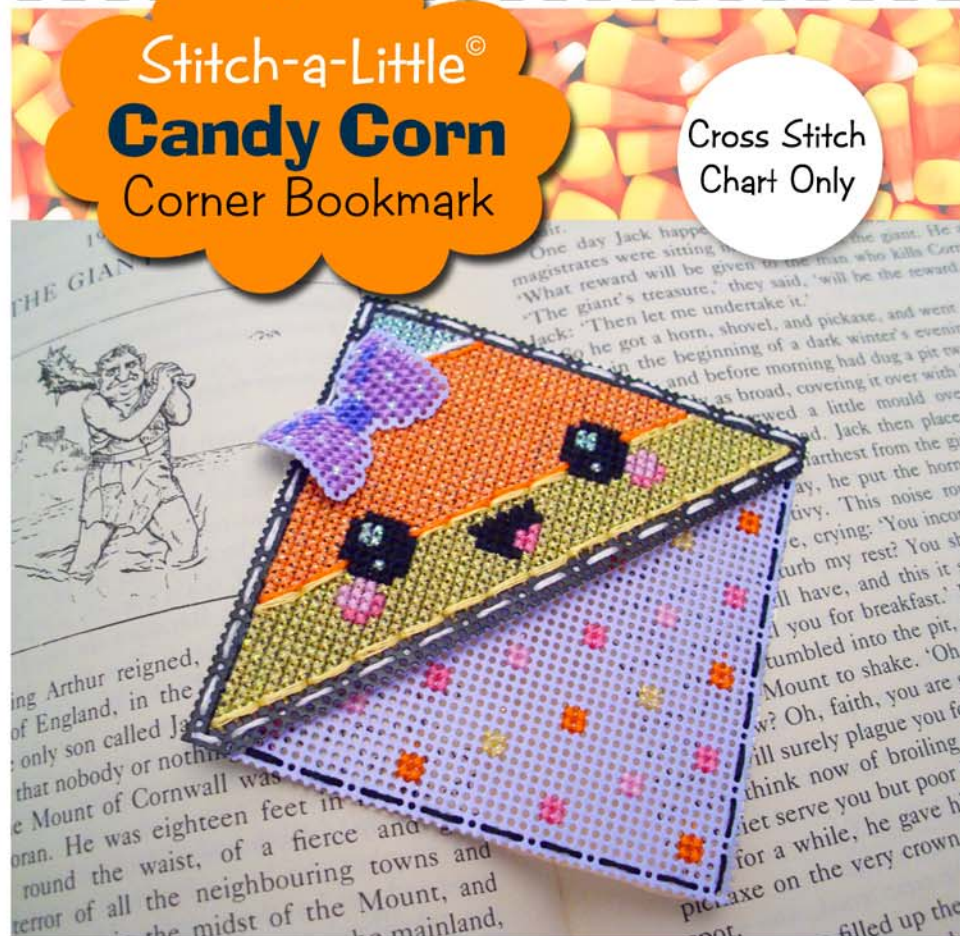

## Material List - Stitch-a-Little **Candy Corn** Bookmark

*In the colors listed in the keys, you will need:*

- 1 - 4.5" x 5.5" piece of 14 count Midnight Black perforated paper
- 1 - 4.5" x 5.5" piece of 14 count Misty Lavender perforated paper
- DMC embroidery floss
- Kreinik #8 Fine Braids

*You will also need:*

- Size 24 tapestry needle
- Sharp pointed embroidery scissors
- Clear drying tacky glue
- Decorative paper to back the finished bookmark

**Tip:** I highly recommend using a pair of sharp pointed embroidery scissors when cutting perforated paper to get in and out of tight corners.

I also recommend a #24 tapestry needle when stitching on perforated paper because the larger sized needle stays stuck in the paper and won't slip back down through the hole as easily when at rest between stitches.

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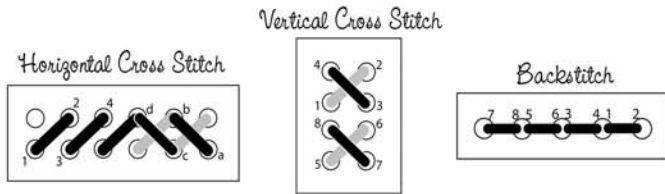

General Stitching Instructions



Finishing Instructions

- 1) Cross stitch and then back stitch the Candy Corn critter on 14 count Midnight Black perforated paper and the square back piece & bow on 14 count Lavender Mist perforated paper as shown on charts 1 & 2.
- 2) Using sharp embroidery scissors, follow the cutting guidelines and cut out all the stitched pieces.
- 3) Stitch the Candy Corn triangle to the top of the square: Line up the edges of the triangle piece with the top right hand corner of the square. Both right sides should be facing out. (See photo) Using 1 ply DMC 310, attach the 2 pieces with a running stitch along the outline of the Candy Corn on the top 2 edges. This line of running stitch should be inside the white decorative running stitch previously stitched and along the very edge of the cross stitches of the Candy Corn. When completed, this will form a pocket. Do not stitch the bottom edge of the triangle.
- 4) If backing the bookmark, use acid free decorative paper of choice. Using tacky glue, apply the backing paper to the back of the square, wrong sides together, and allow to dry. Then use sharp embroidery scissors to cut off the excess backing close to the edges.
- 7) Attach the bow with tacky glue to the Candy Corn. TIP: Before attaching, shape the bow a bit by bending the paper up and curving the sides of the bow. (See photo)
- 8) Enjoy your bookmark!

Back Stitch Key

Symbols	DMC	Location
	310	Back Square: (3 plies) Running stitch on 2 edges
	Blanc	Candy Corn: (3 plies) Running stitch on all 3 edges of triangle & bottom line of top white section
	727	Candy Corn: (3 plies) Top & bottom lines bordering yellow section
	970	Candy Corn: (3 plies) Top & bottom lines bordering orange section



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
