## Hoppy Birthday! A complimentary cross stitch card design by Brooke Nolan



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Needed to complete design: 1 piece 8.5" x 11" White 14 ct. perforated paper; 8" x 10" piece of 28 ct. Zweigart Opalescent White Lugana; DMC floss; Mill Hill glass seed beads; 1 large "Parchment" rectangular opening trifold needlework card (5"x 7" outer dimensions / 3"x 5" inner dimensions); #24 tapestry needle; Short beading needle; Craft knife or small embroidery scissors; Adhesive of choice. (I used Velcro pieces to stick the charms to the needlework card.)

Finished design size, including card frame is 5"x 7".

**Cross Stitch:** Using 2 strands of floss over 2 threads, cross stitch the froggie on the Opalescent Lugana. Using 3 strands of floss, cross stitch the charms on the perforated paper.

Beading: Using 2 strands of #602 Cranberry Md. for Mill Hill #03058 beads and 2 strands of #White for Mill Hill #00479 & #03050 beads, complete the beading as charted. (Note: If you have trouble threading a beading needle with 2 strands of floss, put 1 strand through the eye and pull the end down so there are 2 working strands.)

Back Stitch: Using 2 strands of floss, back stitch the following design areas using the following floss colors: #310 Black - Froggie's eyelash and hat strap. Also the "Hoppy Birthday" lettering; #745 Pale Yellow Lt - Cupcake's cup stripes; #554 Violet Lt - Veins in the butterflies' wings; #602 Cranberry Md - Froggie's mouth and straight stitches around the Hoppy Birthday sign; #904 Parrot Green Vy Dk - Outline around Froggie's eye and lines on his chest, arms and hands.

Finishing Instructions: Using a craft knife or small embroidery scissors, carefully cut out the stitched & beaded perforated paper charms leaving a border of at least one row of stitches all around each charm. Adhere them to the needlework card with double sided tape, glue, pop dots, or Yelcro pieces. See photo for placement.

With 6 strands of #772 Yellow Green Vy Lt floss, make 3 tiny bows with streamers to tack on the balloons. See photo for placement.

Create the froo-froo hat topper as follows: Thread the beading needle with 2 strands #White floss and knot the end. Bring needle up through fabric at the top of Froggie's party hat. Thread 5 Mill Hill #03050 beads onto needle. Then lay all 5 beads down in a snug row on top of the fabric. Put needle back down through the fabric to secure the row of beads. Repeat this process 2 more times but use more beads on each row. See photo for placement of these 3 beaded rows. Secure the froo-froo at the back of the fabric with a knot.

Slip Froggie into his frame and wish someone special a "Hoppy Birthday".




